# Tuition and Financial Aid 2020-21

At St. Rose St. Mary's School, we work very hard to keep all expenses at the lowest level possible while still providing a quality whole-child faith-filled education. The past two years tuition has remained the same. The cost of educating a student continues to rise every year as the cost for salaries, materials, utilities, transportation, etc. continue to rise. Due to rising costs and the we have implemented a 5% tuition increase for the 2020-21 school year.

## Discounts

### Sibling Discount

We offer a tuition discount of \$100 off per student after the first student in a family is registered.

### Referral Discount

For any referral that results in a new family registration a family will receive \$100 off their tuition.

### Returning Students

If you are a student who was previously enrolled at St. Rose St. Mary's school, left the school, and are now returning, we are offering a \$100 discount on this year's tuition.

### Faith Formation Transfer Student

if you are enrolled in St. Rose St. Mary's Faith Formation this year and are admitted to the school you may receive a \$100 discount.

St. Rose St. Mary's School works with families to find a way to make Catholic education accessible to all students- no matter your economic situation. Cost should never prevent a Catholic education. The blessings your family will bring to our community are worth much more than tuition dollars. There are a numbers of ways that tuition can be managed or reduced, including payment plans and multi-child discounts. Additionally, there are many other options to explore, including:

### SSRM Tuition Assistance:

We have generous benefactors that have supported Catholic education in Clintonville in a number of ways including providing tuition assistance. Families must enroll first and then complete the online FACTS Financial Aid Application.

### Wisconsin Parental Choice Program:

Qualifying families can receive state aid that covers the full cost of tuition and fees. This option is available to families who meet residency and eligibility requirements.

### Wisconsin Tax Deduction:

Wisconsin taxpayers can deduct private school tuition expenses from their taxable income. Maximum deduction per child for K-8 is \$4,000.

### SCRIP Tuition Reductions:

Families can purchase gift cards for items purchased daily, such as gas, clothing or groceries. Once you earn \$100 in profits 50% of your earnings will be applied to tuition in April.

### Fundraising

**Raffle Calendars** - Every fall St. Rose St. Mary's School sells raffle calendars. Each family is required to sell 20 calendars before Christmas break.

**Spring Raffle Tickets** - In March St. Rose St. Mary's School sells raffle tickets to help support the Spring Dinner fundraiser. Each family is required to sell 20 books of tickets.

IF YOUR FAMILY CHOOSES TO NOT PARTICIPATE IN FUNDRAISING OR ONLY PARTIALLY PARTICIPATES THE BALANCE WILL BE ADDED TO THE TUITION BILL.

## Tuition Assistance

If your family needs assistance for the 2020-2021 School Year there is financial aid is available. Application for Financial Aid/Tuition Assistance is completed through the FACTS Grant & Aid Assessment the steps are listed below:

1. Go to <https://factsmgt.com/>
2. Go to Parent Log in
3. Click Payment Plans/Financial Aid
4. Click on FACTS Grant & Aid & Click Start Application

All Requests must be submitted by the start of the upcoming school year to be considered for assistance and you must already have a payment plan set up through FACTS in order to be eligible to receive aid or assistance.

# Tuition FREE Catholic Education!



Are you interested in having your children attend St. Rose St. Mary's School but worry that you might not be able to afford it?

Consider applying for SSRM through the Wisconsin Parental Choice Program!

St. Rose St. Mary's School is a participating school in the WPCP (state voucher program) for 2020-21, which provides tuition for eligible students in the state wishing to attend a private school.

### Who's Eligible?

Eligibility is determined by three factors: residency, income, and where your student attended school in the previous year.

Here's how to determine if your family may be eligible:

### Residency

You will need to prove you reside in the state of Wisconsin.

### Income

Eligibility is determined on a sliding scale that considers your family size and 2019 adjusted gross income. At right is a quick chart to consult. You will have to prove your income.

### Previous Attendance

If your student already attends a private school he or she must be entering K4, kindergarten, or 1st grade in 2020-21 to be eligible. If your student attended a public, virtual, or charter school this year (2019-20) or is homeschooled, he or she may be eligible to apply for any grade, K4-8.

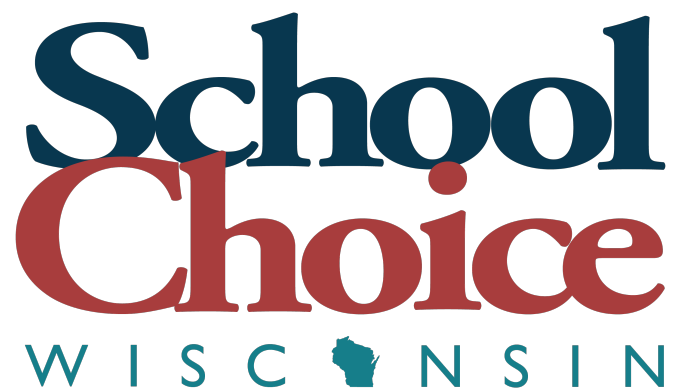

### How to Apply:

If you think your child is eligible, we encourage you to consult with us about how to complete an acceptable application. The WPCP application period begins February 3 and ends April 16. The program has a number limit set by the state. Applicants will learn whether they have been awarded a seat in late spring by the DPI. All online applications and documentation must be submitted to the Wisconsin Department of Public Instruction (DPI) and school before the April 16 deadline. To schedule an appointment please call (715) 201-9913.

### I. Begin Online:

The application begins with an online form. You will need to create an account with the DPI by using your email address and a password that you choose. Then you must sign in using those credentials.

Follow the prompts to fill in the application. When you reach the income section, please choose the "DPI method" of income determination. We recommend, for various reasons, that you do not simply offer your Social Security number to determine eligibility. We also ask that you DO NOT SUBMIT your application. It will be in a queue holding for the next steps when you attend an application session or visit the school. We want to be certain that the documentation you are providing matches what you are submitting to the DPI online.

### 2. Bring Documentation:

Your application is not complete until you provide acceptable documentation to the school, preferably during our application sessions. Here's what you'll need:

**Residency:** The documentation you provide must have your formal name as used in the application along with the address you used on the application.

Acceptable forms include: a utility bill (gas/electric/cable bill), government correspondence, W-2 statement, or paycheck stub. All must be within a month or so of your application and have a date.

**Income:** Use the DPI method and then provide one of the following: 2019 W-2s, 1040 federal income tax form for 2019, Social Security or SSI benefit statement for 2019. If you do not make enough to file taxes, bring a statement of your 2019 state benefits and child support for the year, which you can access online in most communities.
